**Course.** The course will remain similar to 2011, with a few extra hills thrown in on the first lap, to avoid congestion on the single track. Forest NSW are logging the area around "KOM". If you come to Wingello before these dates for practise runs, you have to follow the *Red Trail* around the logging.
